Claude Michel Pichon 8.50 / 30.00

Sauvignon Blanc (Loire Valley, France)

Aromas of tropical fruits such as passion fruit, jasmine & orange blossom with citrus hints.

Domaine Peiriere Chardonnay 9.00 / 35.00

(Languedoc, France)

Exotic tropical fruit aromas of passion fruit & bananas, followed by intense mouth full of lively fruit cocktail, quite full & pure flavours matched by crisp acidity to finish.

Cave du Florensac 9.50 / 38.00

Picpoul de Pinet (Picpoul de Pinet, France)

Delicate & fresh with an excellent acid/structure balance. Fantastic match to all seafood, especially shellfish.

Cantina Negrar Pinot Grigio DOC 9.00 / 35.00

(Vento, Italy)

This refreshing dry white is lemon in colour, with flavours of fresh green apple & citrus are balanced with aromas of stone fruit.

Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc 10.50 / 40.00

(Marlborough, New Zealand)

Deliciously refreshing, elegant pale yellow colour with intense flavours of passion fruit & gooseberry complemented by an array of citrus on the palate.

GEA Verdejo - Vegan/Organic 8.50 / 35.00

(La Mancha, Spain)

Crispy, fruit & mineral attack, with lovely notes of white flowers, spices, good acidity & lovely notes of herb to the finish.

Bodega Eidosela 10.50 / 42.00

Charquina Albarino (Rias Baixas, Spain)

Crisp white apple, pear & peach notes that mingle together with white floral aromas. Highly aromatic on the palate and nicely balanced with a delicate mineral aftertaste and an elegant finish.

Alain Girard Sancerre (Loire Valley, France) 52.00

Classic Sancerre with aromas of white flowers, lemon, pear & gooseberry. On the palate, good roundness with a vibrantly refreshing acidity.

Bodega Arce du Noe Tempranillo 8.50 / 30.00

(Rioja, Spain)

A great Tempranillo, full bodied yet gentle with a bracing acidity.

Demaine Peiriere Merlot 9.00 / 35.00

(Languedoc, France)

Medium bodied, red & blackberry fruit flavours with spice & herbs, backbone of softened tannins.

Bodegas Pecina Crianza Rioja 10.50 / 40.00

(Rioja, Spain)

Bright garnet red, with good depth of colour and clarity. Fruity aromas of plums, blackberries & black fruits.

Caldora Montpuciano 9.50 / 36.00

d'Abruzzo DOC (Abruzzo, Italy)

Ruby red with violet highlights, it has cherry, sour cherry & blackberry aromas supported with a balsamic finish.

Growers Tocu River Shiraz 10.00 / 38.50

(NSW, Australia)

Ripe red in colour. The nose is reminiscent of plums and red berries with hints of tobacco & vanilla.

Pascual Toso Select Vine Malbec 11.50 / 44.00

(Mendoza, Argentina)

An elegant, deeply fruity & long finish is the right balance between the natural expression of the grapes & the ageing in oak barrels.

Zorzal Terrior Unico 9.50 / 37.00

(Gualtallary Valley, Argentina)

Bright red fruits, jump out of the glass with gamey notes cola, dried leaves & forest floor. A rich, soft and supple mouthfeel with light tannin & medium acidity.

Chateau Senejac 57.50

(Huot Medoc, Bordeaux, France)

With its bold fruit flavours, robust tannins & acidity, Chateau Senejac is a great wine to match with rich meaty meats.

Cantina di Negrar Amarone DCG 78.50

(Italy, Verona)

Rich & powerful, with a lovely balance of ripe tannins & spiced, concentrated savoury cherry fruit character. A touch of woodsmoke completes the long finish.
